3. OLD BUSINESS:

A) **L3 Harris Firmware Update and Concessions:** The reprogramming of portable radios started. The East Moline Fire Department, the Moline Fire Department were completed, and they were in the process of doing the Moline Police Department when RACOM identified a problem. The issue was if an officer/ firefighter keys up on their portable, then dispatch keys up at the console level during that continuous transmission and releases BEFORE the officer/ firefighter stops speaking, what is heard is just a bunch of clicks, no audio. L3Harris has corrected this issue with a firmware update that RACOM is currently testing here locally. They will need to touch all portables again. The tentative release date to restart this process again is May 22nd, 2023. L3 Harris will be attending the SECC Board meeting on May 25th, 2023. There is also a programming issue with the USB port but the USB issue only affects technicians not end users. The concessions are BeOn, Wi-Fi, GPS, two-year

extension of the warranty of the devices, and L3 Harris has tentatively agreed to continue the two-year contract pricing that is in the current contract. We are waiting to get this in a written document.

- B) **BDA Updates (RICSO):** All the wiring for the RICSO BDA has been run to the fire panel. The sheriff's office is covering that cost. Johnson Controls has to come in to connect the wiring to the fire panel system and the P25 Working Group has agreed to cover that cost.

- C) **Generator Issues:** The Rock Island Water Tower Site is giving a false alarm that the generator is failing. Lakewood Electric and RACOM came out to address the issue. The generator still works but it is showing that is remaining on generator power when it is actually switches back over onto utility power. HM Cragg will replace the part at no cost as it is under warranty. The heater units of the generators are tripping the GFI. We will change those to regular outlets to avoid this concern.
