

TO COMPLAINANT:

PROSECUTION INSTRUCTIONS

If an arrest was made, you must call the Rock Island County State's Attorney's Office by 9 a.m. the next business day to pursue your charges (309) 558-3251.

If no arrest was made but you wish for your case to be reviewed for prosecution, please call the State's Attorney's Office (309) 558-3251 within the next 14 days between the hours of 8 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday and request that your case be reviewed.

When calling the State's Attorney's Officer you will need to provide them the case number at the time of your call. A prosecutor will be assigned to your case to review, and you will be notified in writing within 21 days of your call whether charges will be filed. Please ensure when you call that you provide a valid mailing address.

If you do not wish for any further action to be taken, nothing more needs to be done.

If your incident involved domestic violence or stalking, you may be eligible to obtain an Order of Protection or No Contact/ No Stalking Order.

- Necessary petition paperwork can be obtained at the *Rock Island County Circuit Clerk's Office*, Rock Island County Courthouse, 3rd floor, 210 15th St., Rock Island, IL between the hours of 8 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Monday-Friday.
- Domestic Violence advocates provided by *Family Resources* are available at the Courthouse Monday-Friday, 8 - 11 a.m., to answer questions and assist in completing petition paperwork. You may also call Family Resources with questions related to domestic violence matters (309) 797-6534. After-hours calls can be made to the Crisis Line (309) 797-1777.

Victims over the age of 65 may be eligible for additional assistance from *Alternatives for Older Adults* (309) 277-0167. If anyone under the age of 18 was involved in the incident, additional assistance may be available from the *Illinois Department of Children and Family Services* (309) 794-3500 / 1-800-25-ABUSE.
